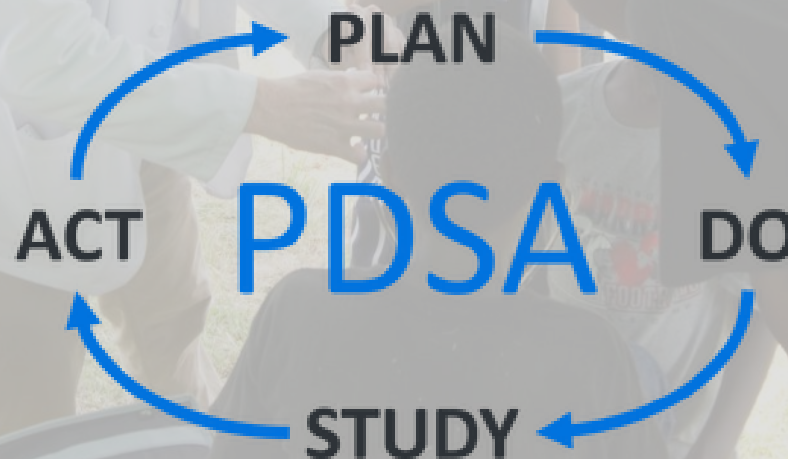

Program Aims to Achieve its Mission

- To provide a clinical learning environment committed to graduate medical education in Greater Evansville, Southern Illinois and Northern Kentucky and the surrounding region.
- To train internists to pursue excellence in holistic delivery of safe, equitable, affordable, quality care; and the health of the communities they serve.
- To care for the poor and vulnerable in our communities and be advocates for a compassionate and just society through our actions and our words.
- To develop physician scholars who are able to navigate and analyze the medical literature, integrating new knowledge into practice.
- To grow residents into leaders who can innovate and practice in rural and resource poor environments, and manage teams in delivering and optimizing care using high reliability principles.

Our Community

Evansville

- Third Largest City in Indiana.
- Approximately 1 Million People live in greater Evansville
- Commercial, medical and cultural hub of the tristate
- Voted the best city in the country in which "to live, work, and play" two years running
- Warm summers, mild winters

Indiana GME Expansion

Indiana believes the best way to attract physicians is to train them.

The legislature began a GME expansion funding program a decade ago



Each year we lose **133** quality residency physicians to other states

Indiana will need an additional **817** Primary Care Physicians by 2030

70%

2/3 of Indiana's medical residency programs occur in the central part of the state, and research shows that nearly 70% of doctors end up practicing medicine near the location of their residency programs

In our neediest communities, the physician-to-citizen ratio is **1:4,622 citizens** compared to **1:1,214 citizens** in communities with less need

Every residency physician generates **\$1.5 million** in economic benefits each year they remain in a community to practice medicine

Statewide, the economic impact of current and planned new residency physicians from Indiana medical residency programs is expected to reach **\$332 million** by 2025

Each physician's practice within the community on average creates an additional **6-7 Jobs**

Each residency physician who stays and becomes a Primary Care Physician within an underserved area generates on average a **\$3.6 MILLION ECONOMIC** impact on the region

Indiana Lawmakers Took Action:

In 2015, the Indiana General Assembly created the **Graduate Medical Education Board** to expand the state's graduate medical residency program

Lawmakers have provided **\$6 million** in 2015 and 2017 for GME expansion

BY 2020 increase the number of residency physicians by **70**

BY 2024 expand the number of graduate medical residency physicians positions offered in Indiana by **350**

221 new residency physician positions have been created so far

- Indiana University School of Medicine
- Fort Wayne Medical Education Program
- Reid Health in Richmond

An additional **90,000** direct Primary Care patients hours will result from the new residency physician positions

\$8.9 Million AWARDED

- Medical Residency Expansion - \$6.2 M
- Medical Residency Program Development - \$2 M
- Medical Residency Feasibility Study - \$744,906

- 1969 St. Mary's Cancer Program is accredited, the first in the tristate
- 1969 St. Mary's ICU opens
- 1970 St. Vincent Family Medicine Residency begins
- 1982 St. Mary's Life Flight the Tri-State's first air ambulance service takes flight
- 1986 St. Mary's/St. Vincent Podiatry Residency begins.
- 1997 St. Mary's celebrates its 125th anniversary
- 1997 Ascension Health formed-the largest not-for-profit Catholic healthcare system in the United States.
- 2005 St. Mary's is the first Level II Adult Trauma Center in the Tri-State.
- 2006 St. Mary's Center for Advanced Medicine opens.
- 2007 St. Mary's opens its Surgical/Trauma ICU.
- 2011 St. Mary's receives nursing Magnet® Designation redesignation 2016 & 2021.

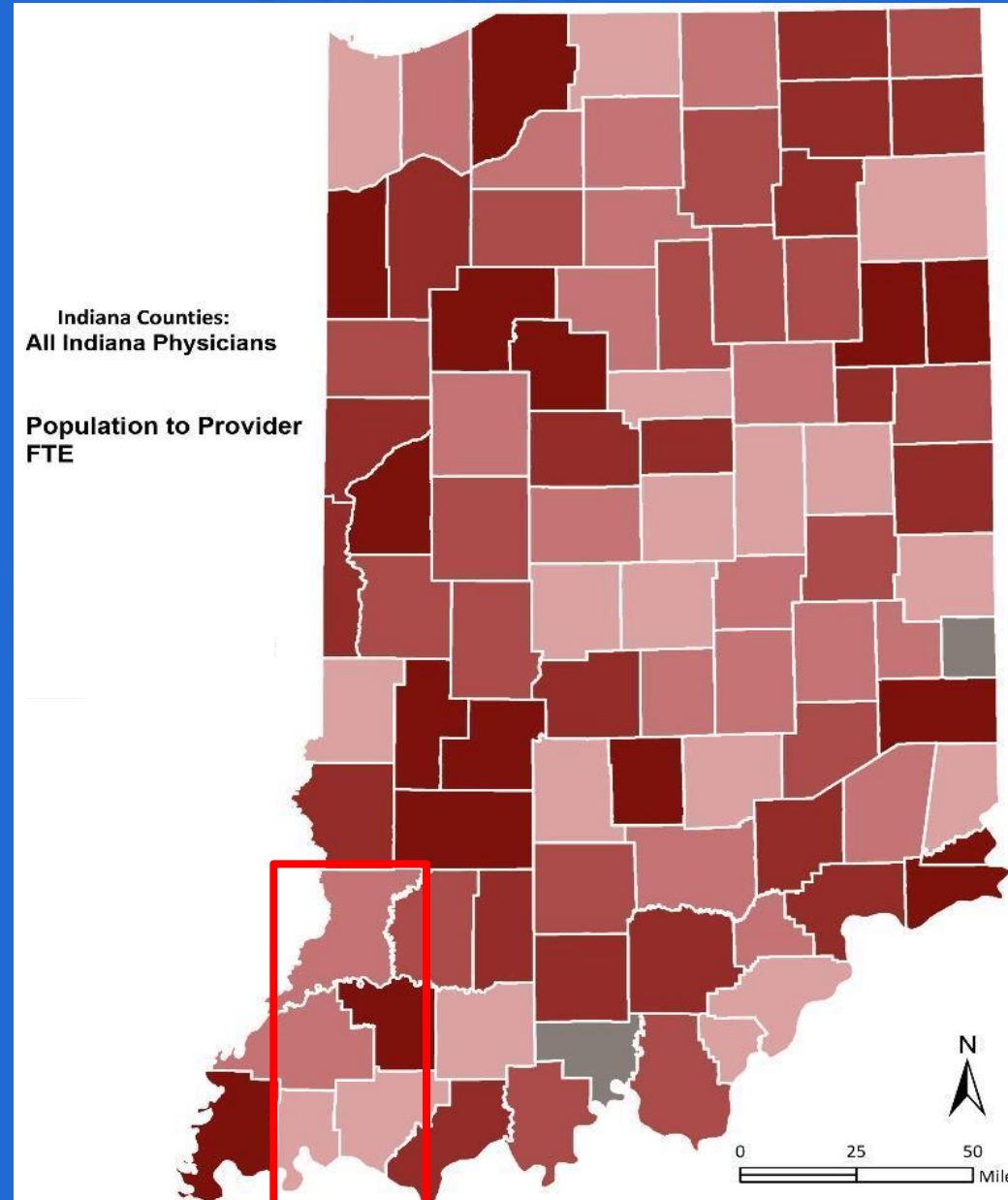

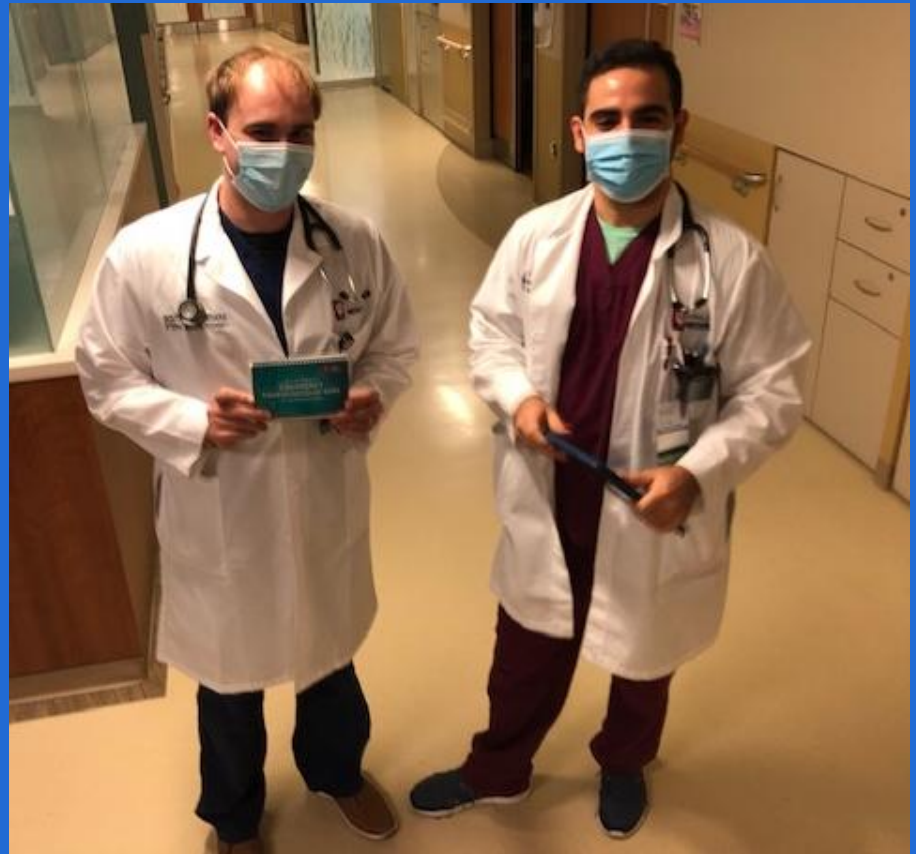

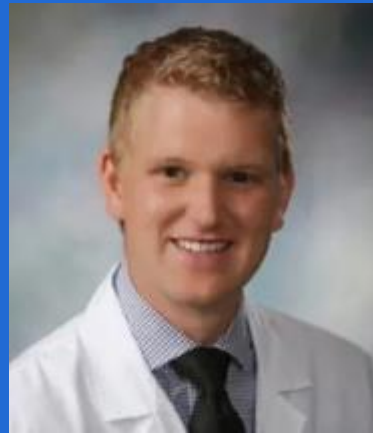
