Academic Bankruptcy Request

Academic bankruptcy permits the faculty to not consider some of an applicant's post-secondary grades if certain conditions are met. Criteria for consideration include the following.

- The applicant's academic record following the academic bankruptcy must be at least 3.0 GPA.
- The applicant must have completed **2** semesters of **full-time enrollment** (12 or more credits each semester) following the date of bankruptcy.

To be considered for an academic bankruptcy, applicants must submit their request using this form to the program director by the <u>January 31</u> application deadline. Additional pages can be included with this form.
