Nonacademic Requirements for the Program.

To be accepted in the program, the applicant must meet the following requirements:

- 1. Be 18 years of age by January 1 of the year applying for enrollment.
- Be eligible to work in the United States as required by the U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (<u>https://www.uscis.gov/i-9-central/form-i-9-acceptabledocuments</u>)

Academic Requirements for the Program.

To be accepted in the program, the applicant must meet **<u>one</u>** of the following requirements:

- 1. Minimum 2.50 College GPA (4.00 Scale) on all academic work from all institutions and a minimum of 9 credit hours completed.
- 2. Minimum 2.50 High School GPA (4.00 Scale).
- 3. Obtain a score of 165 or higher in all four sections of the General Educational Development Test (GED Test)
- 4. Obtain an 18 or higher on the American College Testing (ACT)
- 5. Obtain a 970 Composite Score or higher on the Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT)

General Education Requirements

The following general education courses are *preferred* to be completed before the start of the program. If the general education courses are not completed before the start of the program, the applicant must complete courses in conjunction with Ascension St. Vincent College of Health Professions Surgical Technology Programs curriculum. All general education courses must be completed prior to graduation.
