Several students have stayed in X-ray, while others have found positions in advanced modality training programs: CT(1) or MR(1); two in IR. Goal #1 is good; SLOs are good; utilizing the re-test tool to gain new insight to students' ability to assess a patient's size and possible technique choice.</p> <p>Follow up regarding accuracy of centering score during competency: Students are not always losing points for being off-centered. Discussion followed regarding what entails a repeat exposure vs. losing points. It was agreed that they are not attached to each other in that a picture can be turned in, but is still not centered appropriately. Students should be made aware of the fact that centering allows for proper collimation, too.
